

# ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

## FOR LIGHTNING TALKS & POSTERS



➤ Please be sure to read all guidelines and instructions thoroughly before entering your submission(s)

### General Submission Information

- **Membership Requirements:** You do not need to be part of a NIAMRRE member institution to submit an abstract.
- **Cost of Submission:** It is free to submit an abstract.
- **Conference Registration and Travel Information:** The presenting author of each accepted submission is required to register for and attend the conference. Registration, travel, or hotel assistance will not be provided.
- **Presentation Limits:** You may submit as many abstracts as you wish. Presenting authors will be limited to no more than one (1) Lightning Talk and two (2) posters.
- **Submission Review:** Submissions will be reviewed by a panel of AMR experts and are will be selected based on the submission, available space, diversity in One Health sectors, and overall program balance.
- **Timeline and Deadlines:**
  - January 1, 2025 - The abstract submission form will open.
  - February 21, 2025 - the abstract submission form will close at 11:59 pm CT.
  - March 15, 2025 - submitters will be notified regarding acceptance or rejection of their submission and presenting authors will receive an invitation to present and formatting guidelines. (*Lightning Talk or poster presentation*)

### Important Online Submission Tips

**Required Fields:** Fields with an asterisk(\*) are required. Your submission will only go through for review if these fields are completed.

**Character Count:** Please limit your character counts to 2,000 for the abstract, including spaces and punctuation.

**Title:** The submission title should be specific to the main topic presented. Please do not use abbreviations in the title.

**Content Permission:** By submitting, the author attests that all co-authors of the submission have granted consent for the material to be submitted for presentation and that the submitting author has been granted the right by all co-authors to act on their behalf.
